WHEN IS PROMISING ARTISTS' DAY?

Scheduled for Friday, October 30, 2009, 10:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., the workshops will provide you with opportunities to explore media such as drawing, digital art, watercolor, photography, ceramics and sculpture. Students interested in studying art at Siena Heights will also have the opportunity to inspect the art facilities and meet and interact with our art faculty.

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

If you have a serious interest in attending the Art Department at Siena Heights University, scholarship money is available for students who are seniors and qualify. The maximum renewable scholarship is \$6500 per year. A Portfolio Review Workshop is offered for students who would like to apply for a scholarship.

You must register in advance for this Portfolio Review Workshop. Only ten students, on a first-come, first-serve basis, may participate in this session. If circumstances prevent you from participating in the review, arrangements can be made for another opportunity at a later date.

The portfolio that you bring to the workshop session should contain between six and eight of your best artworks. This work should demonstrate observational drawing skills and understanding of two dimensional design principles. Other media may be represented that show your interests and skills.

Once your place in the Portfolio Review Workshop has been confirmed, you will be sent a questionnaire that you must fill out and bring with you to the critique.

WORKSHOP SELECTION

Drawing, Digital Art, Watercolor, Photography, Ceramics, Sculpture Workshops will be offered in the morning and once again in the afternoon. Hands-on activities will be offered whenever possible. The number of students attending each workshop will be kept small for maximum instructor interaction. All students will attend the introduction, lunch, and closing activities.

Pre-registration is required to ensure that all students will have places reserved for them. Fill out the form below and return it before Friday, October 23, 2009. Workshops will be assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis and every effort will be made to accommodate your requests.

WORKSHOP DESCRIPTIONS

Drawing Workshop

Students will draw at easels with charcoal from an arranged set up emphasizing tonal value and composition.

Digital Art Workshop

Using Photoshop you will learn how to cut apart images, spill ink, and splatter paint. You will then put all of these together, without even getting dirty.

Ceramic Art Workshop

Learn to handbuild curious cups and decorate surfaces with texture and other additive and reductive sculptural techniques.

Watercolor Workshop

This workshop will introduce students to mixing color and making washes with watercolor. We will paint a small watercolor during the workshop.

Sculpture Workshop

The sculpture workshop will present two types of mold making that can reproduce body parts and objects quickly and cheaply. The first is the "Flexwax" mold technique and the second is silicone mold making. Participants will be given an opportunity to cast their own fingers out of plaster.

Photography Workshop

This workshop will take place in the photography lab and will focus on the camera-less technique of the photogram to create a work of art. By placing simple objects in contact with light sensitive photo paper, unusual and intriguing effects can be created. We will be making postcards and 5" x 7" photos in the darkroom.

Portfolio Review Workshop

This workshop is only open to preregistered seniors. Two art professors will review a portfolio of each student's artwork in a small group setting. A maximum of ten participants will be accepted into this workshop session. You must register in advance for this workshop. See Scholarship Information above for more details.

Art Teacher Roundtable

This afternoon workshop session is exclusively for art teachers and will include a monotype demonstration and a group discussion on issues facing art teachers.
